A. <u>Discussion and Direction on Reactivating the Foundation Board and Scheduling a Special Meeting</u> Director of Community Relations Jasmin LoBasso gave a brief background history of the Foundation Board before discussion to activate the Foundation Board. AFTER DISCUSSION, BOARD DECIDED TO HAVE A SPECIAL MEETING AFTER THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING SCHEDULE FOR FEBRUARY 24, 2025.

B. Proposal for the Gym Floor Restoration at Riverview Community Center, Resolution #02-25

Director of Operations and Maintenance Mike Evans requests Board approval of proposal for the gym floor restoration at Riverview Community Center, the restoration includes refinishing of original wood floor, repairs, repainting of game lines and center logo, floor finish and sealer. Mr. Evans stated that this project will be completed in about six weeks. AFTER DISCUSSION, BOARD APPROVED RESOLUTION #02-25 PROPOSAL FOR THE GYM FLOOR RESTORATION OF RIVERVIEW COMMUNITY CENTER.

Mr. Evans stated that NOR received 100% match, and the playground is built out rather than up. Director of Operations and Maintenance Mike Evans requests Board approval for purchase and installation of a steel hip roof picnic shelter for North Highland Park. Mr. Evans stated that the existing picnic shelter at North Highland Park has reached its usable capacity and maintaining the wood structure has become costly. This is one of two wood frame structures, built in the late 70's early 80's. Mr. Evans responds to Board questions. AFTER DISCUSSION, BOARD APPROVED RESOLUTION #04-25 FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A REPLACEMENT SHELTER FOR NORTH HIGHLAND PARK.

E. Purchase of Site Amenities for Stockdale River Ranch Community Park, Resolution #05-25

Director of Planning and Construction Steph Thisius provide updated Resolution and memo to the staff and Board members. Ms. Thisius requests Board approval for the purchase of site features and amenities for phase one of Stockdale River Ranch Park. Phase one is currently under construction and under the agreement there are amenities specified to District standards that NOR is providing to the contractor for installation. AFTER DISCUSSION, BOARD APPROVED RESOLUTION #05-25 FOR THE PURCHASE OF SITE AMENITIES FOR STOCKDALE RIVER RANCH COMMUNITY PARK.

F. Mission Lakes Park Sites Discussion

General Manager Bret Haney discussed the letter received in December by Lennar Homes requesting the Mission Lakes Park land be relinquished to the City of Shafter. Mr. Haney commented that the District's recommendation is not to relinquish the rights of these parks to Lennar and these parks are part of our master plan and NOR is best suited to run these parks; lastly NOR is committed to work with Lennar Homes. Mr. Haney also mentioned that NOR staff were surprised to have received the letter when they met with Lennar Homes and their architect in October of 2024. Parks and Recreation departments discussed the impact it would have on the recreation side if the lands were to be relinquished; currently all NOR parks are maxed out and reservations are 33 percent higher since Covid. Director of Recreation Lauren Cronk added that the potential is endless in the recreation side, her staff are very excited and already have lots of recreational ideas for Mission Lakes Park. In the Parks department Director of Operation and Maintenance Mike Evans added that maintenance will not have an issue maintaining Mission Lakes Park. Director of Community Relations Jasmin LoBasso added that NOR has a strong positive reputation and feedback from the public is that NOR parks are clean. Melony Haigh commented that Lennar Homes stands firm on awarding Mission Lakes Park to the City of Shafter because of timeline issues and quality. According to Ms. Haigh Lennar Homes does not have the time to wait for a secondary approval and gave an example of the Marcona Park; Lennar Homes

has been waiting for a response from NOR since they received a letter in the mail stating that they will receive comments on January 24, 2025, and have not. Director of Planning and Construction Steph Thisius responded to Ms. Haigh comments, NOR returned comments sent out Monday, January 27, 2025, dated Friday, January 24, 2025. Ms. Thisius mentions that the comments were very minimal and that NOR wants to see the specifications of a few items.

Board members commented that without a timeline from Lennar Homes and NOR it would be hard to make any decisions. Board asked Lennar Homes to provide a timeline.

Director of Planning and Construction Steph Thisius requested that Lennar Homes provides a timeline the week of January 27, 2025, to allow the Planning and Maintenance departments to review. NOR will provide a timeline at the next scheduled meeting.

G. Austin Creek Park Site Discussion

General Manager Bret Haney discussed that he met with Justin Batey and before the board is a draft agreement of the Austin Creek Park Donation, phase one. Mr. Haney highlighted section 1.1c of the agreement, staff feels that section should be blank to allow range and flexibility. Staff clarified board member's concerns; if donation is returned it does not mean the park won't get built and regarding a time frame "up to the fourth year" gives NOR breathing room.

Board members commented that it was great that we are getting closer to an agreement and would like to see a time frame. Ms. VanAlstein did not like the language indicated in the agreement that if the donation is returned the District is not obligated to construct any portion of Austin Creek Park. They agree to include the Batey's demands to include a parking lot of at least ten parking spaces emphasizing the importance of parking spaces for accessibility and a picnic shelter. The board also considers accepting donations for benches.

Justin Batey discussed how important the two items that need to be on the agreement for the Batey family to agree are at least ten parking spaces and picnic shelter for phase one. Mr. Batey states that the Batey family wants to be involved in every step of the way but not necessarily making decisions.

Direction from the board is to add the two items to the agreement.

H. 2025-2026 Capital Improvements Projects Workshop

Director of Planning and Construction Steph Thisius handed out the Capital Improvement Projects Workshop (CIP) handouts to the staff and board. Ms. Thisius explains the areas of responsibilities and the reason for color coding; the responsibilities in blue are going to be handled by the finance department, all responsibilities in violet are going to be handled by the planner, and the responsibilities in orange will be handled by the maintenance department. Ms. Thisius reviews each page of the handout and highlights that the planning and construction department has taken more projects on with low staffing and that this workshop is to show the board members what projects NOR is currently working on and will be. Ms. Thisius commented that next month she will need comments from the board regarding this workshop to finalize the budget. Chairperson Jenifer VanAlstein opened the floor for public comments; Mr. Batey asked the board, and staff how does park development impact fees work and can staff allocate funds from Quimby fees to Austin Creek? Ms. Thisius responds and explains how funds are allocated and how Quimby fees work. After discussion Ms. Thisius reminded the board to review the CIP workshop handouts.

Director of Recreation Lauren Cronk reported that Recreation Specialist Ricky Meyers will be partnering with Recreation Manager Sonia Quill for a safety aquatics program; Riverview is getting ready for their court base parenting classes. Ms. Cronk reviewed all current program and relayed a message from recreation staff that staff wants to keep Mission Lakes.

Director of Community Relations Jasmin LoBasso handed out a copy of the new spring fun book and highlighted the expansion of the easter egg hunt, NOR is celebrating 70 years of service, and expansion of NOR's social media.

TITLE: Construction Donation Agreement with Batey Family for Austin Creek Park

RECOMMENDATION: That the Directors approve the agreement with the Batey's for the Construction Donation Agreement for Austin Creek Park

FISCAL IMPACT: None at this time.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION: There has been no previous Board action.

BACKGROUND: The Batey family approached the District to propose a donation toward the construction of Austin Creek Park. The site for Austin Creek Park was dedicated in the 1990s and has remain undeveloped due to the lack of funding available to construct the approximately 10 acres of the park land. The District and the Batey's have been working toward a Construction Donation Agreement and present to your Board a draft of the agreement that is nearly complete. The items of note in the agreement are as follows:

- \$100,000 up front donation solely for use toward professional services the entirety of \$100k can and will be used for this purpose before District funds are used.
- District will spend the remainder of this calendar year holding minimum of 2 public meetings, creating/modifying the conceptual design based on those meetings, obtain a construction estimate, and determine what phase 1 will be based on known funding. District will then present for final approval by next year's CIP meeting.
- From approval of Phase 1, District has up to 4th anniversary to complete shovel-ready condition which includes completing design development, construction documents

and specifications for Phase 1, and approve the construction budget, and received Board approval to commit funds and proceed with construction.

- Upon shovel-ready condition, Batey's will donate \$2,000,000 toward construction of Austin Creek. District has up to 1st anniversary after shovel-ready condition to begin construction or else Batey's can request return of donation. If donation is returned, District is under no obligation to construct any portion of Austin Creek Park
- Agreement requires District to reserve \$1.2 million in funds toward this project. This can and will be accomplished as Austin Creek is added to the CIP approval next year.
- Agreement includes an architectural feature in recognition of the Batey's generosity, the design of which will be discussed through the process, but the District retains final say with Batey input.
- The agreement includes a picnic shelter and 10-space parking lot to be included in Phase 1 as minimum improvements.

CHARITABLE DONATION AGREEMENT

This **CHARITABLE DONATION AGREEMENT** (this "<u>Agreement</u>") is entered into this ______ day of February, 2025 (the "<u>Effective Date</u>") by and between **NORTH OF THE RIVER RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT**, a California recreation and park district (the "<u>DISTRICT</u>"), **BATEY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION**, a California corporation ("<u>BATEY DEVELOPMENT</u>"), and **RUTH GAYLE BATEY**, **TRUSTEE of THE BATEY FAMILY CHARITABLE TRUST dated November 6, 2015** (the "<u>BATEY TRUST</u>"). The DISTRICT, BATEY DEVELOPMENT, and the BATEY TRUST are each referred to singularly as "party" and collectively as the "parties" on a generic basis.

Recitals

This Agreement is made and entered into in reliance upon the accuracy of the following facts and circumstances, which are hereby acknowledged by the parties to be accurate, complete and true:

A. The DISTRICT owns certain real property located in Northwest Bakersfield at or near the intersection of Jenkins Road and Austin Creek Avenue, consisting of approximately 9.33 acres, identified as Kern County Assessor Parcel Numbers 529-012-10 and 529-012-11, and which is the site of the prospective planned neighborhood park under the ownership and control of the DISTRICT, and which shall be known as "Austin Creek Park" pursuant to Resolution #62-02 of the Board of Directors of the DISTRICT (hereinafter referred to as "AUSTIN CREEK PARK");

B. BATEY DEVELOPMENT and the BATEY TRUST (collectively, "BATEY") desire to make restricted donations to the DISTRICT to facilitate and expedite the development and construction of the AUSTIN CREEK PARK, subject to the terms and conditions herein;

C. The DISTRICT desires to accept from BATEY, the restricted donations described herein to assist with the DISTRICT's efforts to fully design, develop and construct AUSTIN CREEK PARK, according to DISTRICT's standards and specifications, subject to covenants, terms and conditions of this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

Agreement

1. <u>Restricted Donations</u>.

1.1 <u>Professional Services Donation</u>. Within thirty (30) days of the Effective Date, BATEY DEVELOPMENT and BATEY TRUST, shall each donate to the DISTRICT the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$50,000.00), for a total donation of One Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$100,000.00, the "Professional Services Donation"), and the DISTRICT agrees to accept the Professional Services Donation. The Professional Services

Donation shall be used solely to secure and compensate the consultants and/or other professional services necessary to complete the design of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, including without limitation: landscape architecture; mechanical, electrical, and plumbing engineering; surveying; land development engineering; and civil engineering (the "Professional Services"). The Professional Services Donation shall first be used solely for outside Professional Services and shall not be used for any other purpose, including without limitation, the payment of compensation to DISTRICT personnel. Once Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK is designed with completed construction documents, if excess funds remain from the Professional Services Donation, any excess funds remaining shall be applied to the development and construction budget for Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK.

1.2 <u>The Contingent Construction Donation</u>. If AUSTIN CREEK PARK is in Shovel Ready Condition (as defined in paragraph 1.3(a), below) no later than the date that is the fourth Anniversary (as defined below) of the Effective Date (the "Park Condition Deadline"), then within thirty (30) days of written notice by the DISTRICT of such Shovel Ready Condition, the BATEY TRUST shall donate the amount of Two Million Dollars and Zero Cents (\$2,000,000.00) (the "Construction Donation") to the DISTRICT and the DISTRICT agrees to accept the Construction Donation. The Construction Donation shall be used solely to develop and construct Phase One (as defined in 1.3(c), below) of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, and for no other purpose, including without limitation, payment of DISTRICT Expenses.

- a. If AUSTIN CREEK PARK is not in Shovel Ready Condition by the Park Condition Deadline, the BATEY TRUST shall not be obligated to make the Construction Donation and may, at its sole and absolute discretion, terminate this Agreement by providing written notice to the DISTRICT.
- b. In the event the DISTRICT has not started construction of Austin Creek Park by the 1st Anniversary of receipt of the Construction Donation, the BATEY TRUST, may, in its sole and absolute discretion, demand the return of the Construction Donation to the BATEY TRUST, excluding any accrued interest, and may, at its sole and absolute discretion, terminate this Agreement by providing written notice to the DISTRICT.
- c. If, for any reason permitted under this Agreement, the DISTRICT returns, or is required to return the Construction Donation to the BATEY TRUST, the DISTRICT shall be under no obligation to continue any further design, development, or construction of any portion of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, including Phase One (as defined in Paragraph 1.3(c) below).
- 1.3 <u>Definitions</u>. As used in this Agreement:
 - a. "<u>Anniversary</u>" shall mean the date that is Three Hundred Sixty-Five (365) days from the Effective Date.

- b. "<u>Shovel Ready Condition</u>" shall mean that:
 - i. By the 1st Anniversary, the District has held at least two (2) community meetings and developed a conceptual design of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, which shall include a phased approach to the construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK;
 - ii. By the 4th Anniversary, the DISTRICT has: (1) completed the design development of AUSTIN CREEK PARK; (2) completed construction documents and specifications for Phase One (as defined in Paragraph 1.3(c) below) of AUSTIN CREEK PARK; (3) approved the construction budget for Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK; (4) has the funds available to complete Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK once construction starts; and (5) the DISTRICT's Board of Directors have given the DISTRICT final approval to move forward with construction of Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK.
- c. "<u>Phase One</u>" shall mean that portion of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, based upon the approved and completed conceptual design of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, that the DISTRICT is financially able to construct based on available resources, including utilization of one hundred percent (100%) of the Construction Donation and Development Funds (as defined in Paragraph 4.2(c) below). Phase One improvements shall include at least: one (1) group picnic shelter and ten (10) off-street parking spaces.

2. <u>Covenants, Authority and Responsibilities</u>. The parties acknowledge and agree as follows:

- 2.1. <u>The DISTRICT</u>.
 - a. The DISTRICT shall use the Professional Services Donation solely for the purposes identified in paragraph 1.1 and shall not suffer the use of the Professional Donation for any other purposes.
 - b. If the DISTRICT satisfies the conditions in paragraph 1.2 for the Construction Donation to be made, or the Construction Donation is otherwise made to the DISTRICT by the BATEY TRUST, the DISTRICT shall deposit the Construction Donation in an interest-bearing account, owned by and in the name of the DISTRICT, to be maintained separate from the general purpose accounts or funds of the DISTRICT, the City of Bakersfield (the "<u>City</u>") or the County of Kern (the "<u>County</u>"). The DISTRICT shall only use the Construction Donation, including any interest accrued thereon, for the purposes specified in paragraph 1.2 and shall not suffer the use of the Construction Donation for any other purpose.

- c. The DISTRICT shall start construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK no later than the 1st Anniversary of receipt of the Construction Donation from the BATEY TRUST. In the event the DISTRICT has not started construction of Austin Creek Park by the 1st Anniversary of receipt of the Construction Donation and the BATEY TRUST demands the return of the Construction Donation, the DISTRICT agrees to promptly return the Construction Donation to the BATEY TRUST, excluding any accrued interest, which the DISTRICT shall have the right to keep and use in its sole and absolute discretion.
- d. Subject to paragraphs 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 2.1(a), 2.1(b), and 2.1(c), the DISTRICT shall retain full, final and exclusive authority and on all aspects of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, including without limitation: (i) the design, development, and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, (ii) the selection and retention of consultants and other professional service providers; and (iii) the schedule for the development and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, which authority shall in all cases be exercised in the DISTRICT's sole and absolute discretion, based upon DISTRICT's standards and specifications, provided, however that the DISTRICT shall use its best efforts to proceed in a reasonable and expeditious manner in the development and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK. Further, subject to the DISTRICT's exclusive authority, the District shall receive and give reasonable consideration to input, suggestions, or recommendations received from BATEY regarding the design of AUSTIN CREEK PARK.
- e. If the Construction Donation is made by the BATEY TRUST, the DISTRICT shall contribute at least One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$1,200,000.00) in Development Funds (as defined in Paragraph 4.2(c) below), for the design, development and construction of Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK. The Development Funds contributed by the DISTRICT, as stated herein, shall be in addition to the Construction Donation, and shall only be used for the design, development and construction of Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK.

2.2. <u>BATEY</u>. Subject to the restrictions, conditions and rights identified in paragraphs 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 2.1(a), 2.1(b), and 2.1(c), BATEY shall have no authority to: (i) impose any condition, obligation, or requirement on the DISTRICT regarding the design, development, or construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, including, without limitation, which consultants or other professional services the DISTRICT may retain, the schedule of the design, development, or construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK; (ii) control, manage, obstruct, or interfere with the design, development, or construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK; (iii) dictate or control the DISTRICT's development and/or construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK. The foregoing lack of authority of BATEY shall not be deemed to prohibit BATEY from offering opinions, suggestions,

or recommendations regarding the overall design of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, but the same shall be precatory, and not establish further obligations or conditions on the DISTRICT as related to AUSTIN CREEK PARK. Further, the foregoing lack of authority of BATEY is expressly limited to the design and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK as described in this Agreement and shall not expressly or impliedly include or relate to any conditions of approval, obligations and/or requirements of BATEY DEVELOPMENT imposed by any governmental entity, to design and construct any street improvements adjacent to AUSTIN CREEK PARK, if any.

3. <u>Architectural Feature</u>. The DISTRICT, in recognition of the generosity of the BATEY TRUST, shall include or incorporate in the design of AUSTIN CREEK PARK a plaque or other similar architectural feature (the "<u>Feature</u>"). While the DISTRICT will solicit input regarding the design of the Feature from the BATEY TRUST, if input is provided, such input shall be subject to the limitations described in Section 2.2, and the DISTRICT reserves all authority, rights and discretion as to the form, design, size and placement of the Feature.

- 4. <u>Representations and Warranties</u>.
 - 4.1 BATEY represents, warrants, understands and agrees as follows:
 - a. The Professional Services Donation to the DISTRICT shall only impose those restrictions and conditions expressly stated in this Agreement, but shall not otherwise impose any deadline, timeline, or obligation on the DISTRICT to complete the design, development or construction of the AUSTIN CREEK PARK by any specific date or under any specific timeline.
 - b. The Construction Donation to the DISTRICT, if made, shall only impose those restrictions, conditions, deadlines, timelines, and obligations expressly stated in this Agreement, but shall not otherwise impose any deadline, timeline, or obligation on the DISTRICT to complete the design, development or construction of the AUSTIN CREEK PARK by any specific date or under any specific timeline.
 - c. The DISTRICT is a public entity bound by certain rules, laws, statutes, ordinances, and obligations in relation to the design, development, and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, including without limitation, the California Public Contract Code.
 - d. The DISTRICT has advised BATEY that the design, construction and development of Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK may take approximately five (5) years to complete under optimal circumstances, excluding unforeseen issues or problems that may extend such timeframe.
 - 4.2 The DISTRICT represents, warrants, understands and agrees as follows:

- a. The DISTRICT is a public entity bound by certain rules, laws, statutes, ordinances, and obligations, including, but not limited to the California Public Contract Code, and must ensure its compliance with same throughout the entirety of the design, development, and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, and which could result in delays in completion of AUSTIN CREEK PARK.
- b. The DISTRICT anticipates that under current conditions, and with the Professional Services Donation and the Construction Donation identified herein, the design, development and construction of Phase One of AUSTIN CREEK PARK may take approximately five (5) years to complete, excluding any unforeseen issues or problems that may arise throughout the process, which may or will extend that timeframe.
- c. As of the Effective Date of this Agreement, the DISTRICT has One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$1,200,000.00) in development funds available to be directed toward the design, development and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK (the "Development Funds").
- d. The development, design and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK shall be achieved in a manner that complies with DISTRICT standards and specifications, along with all laws, statutes, regulations and ordinances required of the DISTRICT relating to the design, development and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK.

5. <u>Donor Recognition and Public Announcement</u>. No recognition, acknowledgement, announcement, or other public disclosure of the Construction Donation or the Professional Services Donation shall be made without the prior written approval of the BATEY and the DISTRICT. However, the parties hereto acknowledge that the DISTRICT is a public agency subject to the California Government Code Section 54950 et. seq. (the "Brown Act") and that its meetings are required to be held in public, and its records subject to disclosure.

6. <u>Board Approval Required</u>. The parties agree that this Agreement shall not be effective or binding on either party until the acceptance and approval of the Board of Directors of the DISTRICT. The acceptance and approval of the Board of Directors of the DISTRICT shall be confirmed upon the signature of the Chairperson of the Board of Directors hereto below. If this Agreement is not so accepted and approved, the Agreement shall be null and void as to all parties hereto.

7. <u>Non-Liability of BATEY</u>. In recognition of BATEY's lack of authority regarding the design and construction of AUSTIN CREEK PARK, BATEY shall not be held liable for damages for any third-party claim(s) relating to the AUSTIN CREEK PARK, on account of the Professional Services Donation or the Construction Donation, if any, or any condition thereof.

8. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties and constitutes an integration of the entire agreement, contract and understanding of the parties as it relates to AUSTIN CREEK PARK and the donations identified/detailed herein. All prior agreements, conditions, contracts, covenants, promises, representations, understandings or warranties, whether oral or written, concerning the subject matter of this Agreement are expressly superseded hereby and have no further force or effect.

9. <u>Amendment.</u> The terms and provisions of this Agreement may not be waived, altered, modified or amended except in writing executed by the parties hereto.

10. <u>Non-Assignment</u>; <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. Neither party may assign, pledge or otherwise encumber this Agreement or any rights or obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the other party, which consent may be reasonably withheld. This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties' respective legal heirs, successors and permitted assigns.

11. <u>Waiver</u>. None of the provisions, warranties, terms or conditions of this Agreement shall be deemed to have been waived except in a writing signed by the party against whom the waiver is claimed.

12. <u>Governing Law and Venue.</u> This Agreement shall be construed, enforced and interpreted pursuant to the internal substantive law and not the law of conflicts, of the State of California. The parties also agree that this Agreement is made and to be performed in Kern County, California, and therefore that the only proper venue for any litigation shall be the Kern County Superior Court, Metropolitan Division.

13. <u>Construction</u>. Headings are used herein for convenience only and shall have no force or effect in the construction or interpretation of this Agreement. As used in this Agreement, the singular includes the plural and masculine includes the feminine and neuter. This Agreement shall not be construed against the party drafting it but shall be construed fairly and equitably as though it was the joint product of the parties. References to a paragraph shall include all subordinate subparagraphs, unless the contact clearly shows otherwise.

14. <u>Further Assurances.</u> The parties agree to do or to cause to be done such further acts and things and to execute and deliver or to cause to be executed and delivered such additional agreements and instruments as the other party may reasonably request to carry into effect the purposes of this Agreement.

15. <u>No Joint Venture</u>. This Agreement is not intended to create, and shall not be construed as creating, any partnership, joint venture or other entity between or including the parties or any of them.

16. <u>Effect of Illegality</u>. If any paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof shall become illegal, null or void for any reason or shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, null or void, or against public policy, the remaining paragraphs, sentences, clauses or

phrases hereof shall not be affected thereby and the parties shall negotiate an equitable adjustment of the affected provision with a view toward effecting the purpose of the Agreement.

17. <u>Counterparts/Electronic Transmission</u>. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original for all purposes. Electronically transmitted signed versions of this Agreement shall be deemed as valid and enforceable as the original signed version(s).

18. <u>Effective Date</u>. Subject to paragraph 6 above, this Agreement shall become effective immediately upon the last date of execution by all the parties hereto.

TITLE: Discussion Regarding Park Sites Within the Mission Lakes Master Planned Community

RECOMMENDATION: That the Directors consider staff updates and recommendations amidst ongoing discussions with Lennar Homes of California, LLC for the future development of park sites within the Mission Lakes Specific Plan, Shafter, CA.

FISCAL IMPACT: None at this time.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION: There has been no previous Board action.

BACKGROUND: The Mission Lakes Specific Plan was originally approved March 2005 by the City of Shafter. A revision was done to amend the specific plan in April and June 2024 to make all recreation areas public, as opposed to public and private and to increase the density of residential development, revised the lot standards to 4,000 sq. ft. from 7,200-, 6,000-, and 5,000- sq. ft. lots, as well as reduced the proposed lake to 3-4 acres instead of 33.1 acres.

Following this Specific Plan Amendment, staff received Tentative Tract Map 7461 in August 2024 and in mid-September, the tract map was conditioned to deed the proposed 2.69 acre park to NOR as a developer-built, turn key park. Standard conditions for these types of

situations include a park development agreement between the developer and NOR, a Noise, Lighting and Glare Covenant to disclose to future and current residents the proximity of a public park and its operations and programming and the inclusion of all parcels into the NOR Park Maintenance District to assist with ongoing maintenance of public lands. This tract map was approved by the Shafter City Council on January 7, 2025.

In late October, staff was contacted to take part in a meeting with Lennar, the City of Shafter and the landscape architect to review proposed concepts in preparation for future development and the community park in Mission Lakes. Staff found the meeting favorable, providing operational and maintenance feedback, suggestions for amenities and overall consideration and support for the community park. Lennar requested NOR's standards in mid-November, which staff responded with the sample templates drafted for a 20 acre park and the approved NOR tree, shrub and groundcover list. It was stated that the sample is conceptual in nature and to reach out if there are any questions. There was no discussion regarding the 2.69 acre park located within Tract 7461.

72 hours prior to the December 2024 board meeting, the board clerk received a letter from Lennar requesting to remove the District's jurisdiction over Mission Lakes' community park; said letter was included in December's correspondence. Lennar provided public comment at the December Board meeting with the request from the Board for staff to review the correspondence and provide discussion at January's Board meeting.

Staff met via web conference with Lennar on January 6, 2025 to discuss the request and also the process needed for approval on the 2 small park sites within the Marcona Preserve development. Lennar wishes to remove the parks within Mission Lakes from NOR's jurisdiction and have the City of Shafter administer the services instead. At the January 2025 Board of Directors meeting, staff presented a discussion item before the Board including the District's capacity for operations and maintenance, recreational programing, rentals and overall capability to accommodate the parks in Mission Lakes. It is presented that North of the River Recreation and Park District has the capacity and readiness to incorporate the parks within the Mission Lakes specific plan. The parks have been planned for within the District's master plan and a critical component of future recreation and park programming for constituents. Board member comments included the request for Lennar to provide staff with the construction/timing schedule for Misson Lakes and for staff to review and provide a response. At this writing, a schedule has not been received by staff.

The plan is based on multiple factors including staff input, Quimby and Development Fee fund historical data, fund projected balances, current project load and project feasibility.

After the CIP Workshop was presented in January, staff requested the Board provide feedback and questions to be discussed at the February Board of Directors meeting. This month, staff is continuing the discussion to address questions preceding budget preparations.

TITLE: Naming of Coffee-Etchart Park Site

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors discuss the naming options and vote to approve a name for the Coffee-Etchart park site.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact with the naming of the park.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION: There is no previous board action with the naming of the park site. Approval of Resolution #39-17 authorized the acceptance of the land dedication and the purchase of the remainder. Approval of Resolution #28-22 authorized the agreement to transfer the land encumbered by Pacific Gas and Electric to North of the River Recreation and Park District.

BACKGROUND: North of the River Recreation and Park District has a naming policy that establishes a consistent rationale for the naming of parks and facilities owned by the District and to provide a sound basis for the management of information to the public. The definitions of Functional and Locational are defined in policy as such:

- Functional: The action or activity normal to the type of proposed park or facility.
- Locational: The place or position geographically where a park or facility may be situated in the District. Common reference could be to streets, tract names, community names or geographic features.

A park or facility name has long range implications for its successful positioning in the minds of the public. Any name must have a rationale that helps the public identify its location in the District as well as the activities in the park and/or facility. The name must imply an easily understood and consistent identity.

• All parks and facilities are to be given names approved by the Board of Directors that have either a functional or locational basis.

- The suggestion of names is to be made by the staff to the Board after consideration of the park's geographic location and intended dominant pattern of activity.
- Staff shall avoid recommending names that have a reference to persons either living or deceased.

Staff discussed the guidelines of the policy requiring parks to have functional and/or locational names. Staff reviewed the geographical location of the park, considering the surrounding developments, roads and related locale. Staff requests the Board discuss the following name options:

- Snow Creek Park
- Snow Ridge Park
- Coffee Park

The Board should discuss and vote on the proposed names, with the park being named by majority vote. Resolution #08-25 will officially name the Coffee-Etchart park site.

TITLE: Naming of Nord-Hageman Park Site

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors discuss the naming options and vote to approve a name for the Nord-Hageman park site.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact with the naming of the park.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION: There is no previous board action with the naming of the park site. Approval of Resolution #50-12 authorized the purchase of the Nord-Hageman site through Chapter 8 Agreement Sale provisions. The District finalized all Chapter 8 provisions and received title to the property in 2018. Approval of Resolution #02-18 authorized the agreement with Trinity West, Inc. dba Batey Homes to dedicate land via the Quimby Act to the District, thus expanding the acreage of the Nord-Hageman site.

BACKGROUND: North of the River Recreation and Park District has a naming policy that establishes a consistent rationale for the naming of parks and facilities owned by the District and to provide a sound basis for the management of information to the public. The definitions of Functional and Locational are defined in policy as such:

- Functional: The action or activity normal to the type of proposed park or facility.
- Locational: The place or position geographically where a park or facility may be situated in the District. Common reference could be to streets, tract names, community names or geographic features.

A park or facility name has long range implications for its successful positioning in the minds of the public. Any name must have a rationale that helps the public identify its location in the District as well as the activities in the park and/or facility. The name must imply an easily understood and consistent identity.

- All parks and facilities are to be given names approved by the Board of Directors that have either a functional or locational basis.
- The suggestion of names is to be made by the staff to the Board after consideration of the park's geographic location and intended dominant pattern of activity.
- Staff shall avoid recommending names that have a reference to persons either living or deceased.

Staff discussed the guidelines of the policy requiring parks to have functional and/or locational names. Staff reviewed the geographical location of the park, considering the surrounding developments, roads and related locale. This area is generally agriculture, with the agricultural residential development in the area constructed in the 1970s and 1980s. Recently, staff worked alongside Vaughn Water Company for the establishment of the Winfield well site, directly east of the future park site. This ensures an adequate water supply not only for the park, but the anticipated residential development and school sites in the future. Staff requests the Board discuss the following name options:

- Winfield Park
- Nord Hageman Park

The Board should discuss and vote on the proposed names, with the park being named by majority vote. Resolution #09-25 will officially name the Nord-Hageman park site.

TITLE: Availability Pay Policy

RECOMMENDATION: Recommend that the board approves a new policy for Availability Pay.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$6,200 to provide a primary and back-up on-call for each night.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION: None.

BACKGROUND: North of the River Recreation and Park District operates 24 individual park sites, where regular maintenance and safety protocols are observed for compliance of public spaces. In anticipation of unforeseen urgent situations, employees in certain classifications must frequently be available to report to work outside their regular work schedule. At the request of their department head or designee, those employees are required to carry a communications device to ensure their availability for these unanticipated circumstances. As compensation for being available to respond to such situations, those employees shall receive a bi-weekly allowance equal to 5% of their bi-weekly base salary.

Currently within Security, the full time Rangers are "on-call" up to four nights per week, requiring them to maintain a district cell phone to receive any emergency after hour calls that may need their response.

To simplify records and in evaluating what other local agencies are doing, the adoption of an Availability Pay policy is recommended. This ensures staff is not only compensated properly for their availability, but records maintained within maintenance, payroll, and finance are streamlined.

Approval of Resolution #10-25 authorizes the adoption of the Availability Pay policy for North of the River Recreation and Park District.

Availability Pay

Due to urgent situations, employees in certain classifications must frequently be available to report to work outside their regular work schedule, at the request of their department head or designee. Such employees shall be required to carry a communications device to ensure their availability.

<u>Availability pay</u>: As compensation for being available to respond to such situations, those employees shall receive a bi-weekly allowance equal to 5% of their bi-weekly base salary.

<u>Callback pay:</u> Employees who do return to work shall be eligible for a 2-hour minimum callback pay, or the total time actually worked, whichever is greater. If called back multiple times within the 2 hours, the employee will only receive compensation for the 2 hours or the total time actually worked, whichever is greater.

<u>After-hour phone calls</u>: Employees required to provide an after-hour service response, but who do not return to work shall be eligible for a minimum of 15 minutes call back pay and compensated for the actual time they work over 30 minutes rounded to the nearest 15 minutes of an hourj..

<u>Eligibility</u>: The classifications eligible to receive this additional compensation will be upon recommendation by their department head and approved by the General Manager.

EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

The Board may, during any regular or special meeting, call for an executive session at which the public is excluded and only those designated by the Board are present. An executive session may be called only for the purpose of discussing any matters relevant to:

- District personnel, including consultations with employee organizations (*Government Code Sections 54957.10; 54957.6; or 54957*); or
- Planned, anticipated or pending litigation in which the District is involved (*Government Code Section 54956.9*); or
- Real property negotiations (Government Code Section 54956.8); or
- Tort or public or workers' compensation liability (Government Code Section 54956.95); or
- License applications by personnel with prior criminal records (*Government Code Section* 54956.7); or
- Threats to public security (Government Code Section 54957); or
- When a public meeting is interrupted such that the orderly conduct of that meeting is unfeasible (*Government Code 54957.9*); or
- To present testimony to a grand jury (*Government Code 54953.1*); or
- Any other purpose as described in/and pursuant to California Code.

HEARINGS

The Board may, in the course of considering matters concerning 1) District personnel, 2) budget, or 3) other matters deemed appropriate, conduct quasi-judicial hearings. Such hearings may be called by either 1) the Board itself, 2) at the request of any District personnel against whom charges, complaints or actions have been brought, or 3) on matters legally mandated by law. In the course of conducting such hearings, the Board shall have the power to examine witnesses under oath, and to exclude from such hearings, during the examination of witnesses, any or all other witnesses in the matter being investigated. The purpose of such proceedings shall be investigative with intent to arrive at a fair decision based on the evidence presented (*Government Code Section 54957*).

BOARD MEETINGS

All meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held in compliance with the Ralph M. Brown Act, California Government Code §54950 through §54962.

REGULAR BOARD MEETINGS

Regular meetings of the Board of Directors will be held once monthly, the third Monday of each month, commencing at 5:30 p.m. at the Administrative Office and conclude upon a duly accepted motion to adjourn. Should the third Monday of any given month correspond to a legal state holiday, the regular meeting shall be held on the Tuesday thereafter. The Board may, at its discretion, change the date and time of its regular meetings provided that the appropriate written notice is posted.

A regular meeting of the Board may be adjourned upon motion to any date prescribed provided that written notice of adjournment shall be posted within 24 hours of adjournment on or near the door of the place where the adjourned meeting was held. Such notice shall state the date, time, and place of the adjourned regular meeting. If the order of adjournment of a meeting fails to state the time of which the adjourned meeting will be held, the meeting will be held at the usual hour specified for regular meetings.

SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS

Special Meetings of the Board of Directors will be held as necessary and may be called by the Board Chairperson, by a majority of the members of the Board of Directors, or by the General Manager.

STUDY SESSIONS

Study Sessions may be called for the purpose of investigating and analyzing a given issue or issues of importance. Such sessions may be scheduled as regular, adjourned regular or special meetings. However, no definitive conclusions or decisions shall be made at a study session.

PROJECT: NOR POOL MITIGATION AND PLANNING

Budgeted Amount: \$50,000

Date Budget Approved: July 15, 2024

Budget Spent to Date: \$0

PROJECT SUMMARY

The NOR Pool was shut down in February 2020 due to, at the time, unknown debris entering the pool. Upon further investigation through May 2020, the unidentified substance was tested and found to be asbestos, at which time the District mitigated the pool and surrounding area to abate and/or contain the contaminant. Since May 2020, staff has been working with insurance and an environmental consultant to find the best approach for a long term, holistic solution at the pool.

STATUS SUMMARY

Date: February 19, 2025

Pipe investigation commenced on June 29-30, 2021 with insurance adjuster, Exponent and contractors onsite. Communication ongoing between NOR staff, environmental consultant and insurance team. Exponent report received mid-October; staff is reviewing and staff's opinion of approach differs. January meeting provided update from insurance; staff responded to comments and investigated information provided. Ongoing discussions with CAPRI, staff review and other contractors/experts lends itself to another investigation at the pool to provide more information. Letter of counterstatement submitted back to CAPRI, agreed to a third-party review via meeting in early October. Forensic engineer has been retained by CAPRI for third party investigation and completed site visit on June 13, 2023. Final report has been received and reviewed with CAPRI. Exponent has provided response to report; staff is working with CAPRI to provide comment and next steps of claim completion/mediation, as of June 12, 2024. As of September 8, 2023, the entire NOR Park site has been fenced due to areas of concern with an unknown substance. A semi-permanent fence has been placed as of early October 2023. Subsurface investigation is needed to collect detailed data. The next phase of investigation commenced June 10th, 2024 and was completed August 1, 2024. Recent discussions have turned to future mitigation of impacted areas, concurrent with the District's future plans of the site. Staff met with all parties February 19 & 20, 2025 to determine mitigation, planning and reporting steps and the District looks at options for the pool site.

Standard Park is due for a major renovation because of age and irrigation inefficiency. Renovation shall include a new irrigation system, state model water efficient landscape ordinance compliance, turf renovation, the addition of compliant planter areas and upgraded amenities as budget allows.

Date: February 19, 2025

The Statewide Park Program Grant (Prop. 68) application was submitted March 12, 2021 and is pending grant review. Grant awards expected to be announced 4th quarter 2021. State requested further information regarding the grant application June 2021 and conducted a site visit on July 7, 2021. Award letter was received June 8, 2022.

Project awarded at \$1,280,475; 50/50 match as a Land and Water Conservation Fund federal grant, administered by the California Office of Grants and Local Services (OGALS). Native American Consultation initial review complete. Proceeding with Section 106 (Historic Preservation) and NEPA documents for National Park Service (NPS); these documents have been completed and turned into the state as of March 1, 2024. Further review from the state required more clarification to the State Office of Historic Preservation, submitted May 6, 2024. OGALS revised the budget narrative forms and map requirements May 2024; met w/ OGALS LWCF staff via web conference June 5, 2024 to go over revisions and requirements. Provided new forms/updates to OGALS June 6, 2024 for final approval by NPS. Contract fully executed November 2024. Staff met internally December 2024 to set a pre-project walk in January 2025 to commence design development to construction documents. Currently processing the deed restriction for the land; to be recorded February 2025 pending state review. Working on tree trimming impacts and initial contracting with civil engineer.

PROJECT SUMMARY

As of August 2015, Bolthouse Properties and the District entered into a legal agreement for the development of Stockdale River Ranch Park. The phased development of Stockdale River Ranch (SRR) will provide the District with an approximately 22-acre community park and associated amenities as defined by the District's Master Plan.

STATUS SUMMARY

Date: February 19, 2025

Zone change has been processed and legal documentation has moved forward within the city. Address has been assigned and Site Plan Review has been approved by the City of Bakersfield. Met w/ Bolthouse December 2021, determined plan schedule and contracting deadline, surveying commenced March 2022. Applied for a CPRS/Gametime Playground Grant in July 2022; awarded September 2022. Civil engineering completed grading and underground infrastructure plans submitted to City October 2022 with final review and permit April 2023. March-April 2023: Construction documents underway; staff currently working on irrigation and site construction. Playground finalized; working on restroom, electrical, site furnishings and picnic shelters. Construction documents are at approximately 70% completion. Official groundbreaking was held June 1st; construction documents are pending budgets and the restroom structure placement. Finalizing construction documents; review plan set was sent to Bolthouse end of September 2023. Plans were bid out for preliminary budget numbers; currently finalizing landscape construction and architectural details. Weekly/bi-weekly meetings with Bolthouse are occurring beginning January 2024 to hone budget, schedule and fine details. PG & E application is being processed. Onsite work completed includes completion of post tension slab for sports courts, curb and gutter for parking lot, and staking/placement of light standards. Finalizing site amenities and landscape plans; picnic shelter plans are approved. Onsite, restroom is up, 90% completion on sports courts, parking lot is complete, site concrete 90% complete. Bolts and footings for the shelters were delivered December 2024. Updates for February include picnic shelter delivery, precon onsite with landscape contractor, initial landscape grading commenced and review of landscape submittals by NOR.
